

DOCUMENTS TO DRIVE IN FRANCE



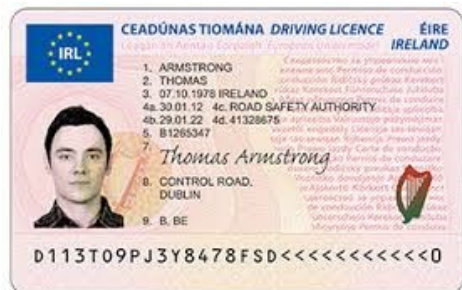
When driving, you should always have :

- The registration card of your car **(A)**
- Your car insurance card **(B)**
- Your passport (or ID if EU national)

If EU license

- Your valid EU license

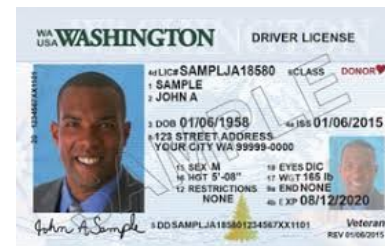


If you have a French special residence card

- Your French special residence card



- Your valid non-EU license +



- Its official translation in French

If non-EU license

- If you don't have a special residence card

- Your regular French residence card

During the first year of residence:

- Your valid non-EU license +
- Its official translation in French

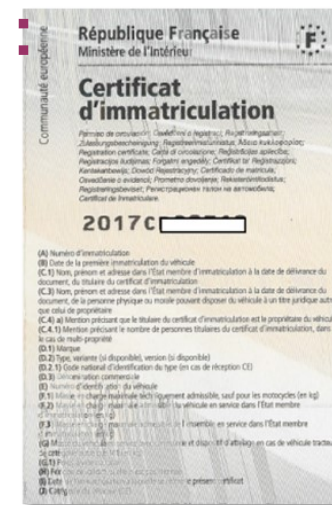
After 1 year of residence:

- French driving license required

(obtained by exchange of your national license if bilateral agreement or by taking the French tests if none)
