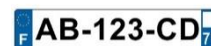

- The **standard number** (A section)
(this number remains linked to the car, even if sold)

This number is used to print white plates*:



- the **diplomatic number** (Z1- beginning with 454K for ITER)
(this number is linked to one person, it will change in case of sale and does not appear at all for French regular registrations, only diplomatic ones)

This number is used to print green plates*:



- * you have the choice to have car plates printed with either number:
- standard number for **white plates** or
 - 454K number for **green plates**

The WO recommends that you use white plates, like local people.
(Only one set of plates is required)

French 'certificat d'immatriculation'
(also called 'carte grise')



- ❖ With a French diplomatic registration card, with or without green plates on the car, you must anyway respect all French road traffic rules (NO immunity on the road).
- ❖ Cars with a French diplomatic registration should not be driven by spouses (or children old enough to drive), if they do not have a special residence card themselves (code AT or FI too).
If you do not respect this rule, you may have problems in case of police checks or with your insurance policy in case of an accident.
