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THE WELCOME OFFICE FRENCH LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

The ability to speak French, even basic French, will provide you with the key to understand French culture and make your everyday life much easier.

The Welcome Office of the Agence ITER France is here to help you with learning French, from complete beginner level to B1 level as described by the Common European Framework of References for Languages (link to the reference levels).

Reaching the B1 level in the French language requires time, work and commitment but thanks to our specifically designed program, this is possible to anyone.

Who can be registered to the French Language Programs of the Welcome **Office?**

The French Language Programs are open to all IO Directly Employed Staff and their spouses/partners.

Training duration

The Welcome Office of the Agence Iter France provides French language programs free of charge for two years (except for Program 5 which is limited to one year) or until the participant reaches level B1 within the two years of training.

Training centers

Our French language programs are **available on three different sites**:

- on ITER site for the ITER staff, -
- in Manosque for the ITER staff and their spouses/partners, -
- and in Aix-en-Provence for the ITER staff and their spouses/partners. -

Registration must be confirmed by the Welcome Office before starting the courses.





Rules of participation for all the French Language Programs To register, please contact: <u>magali.chabrand@iter.org</u>

Each person signing up for the French Language Programs has to:

- Sign a <u>Training Commitment Form</u> to attend classes regularly and do personal work

- Register to one program at a time
- Know that switching school in the course of the year is not possible
- Inform the teachers about their non-attendance
- Agree that when they have been absent more than 2 times without justification they will be asked to leave the program

1/ THE ITER-SITE FRENCH LANGUAGE PROGRAM

This program is open to all ITER directly employed staff. The Welcome Office partners with two teachers, Florence Metzger and Sandrine Lamblin, both specialized in French as a Foreign Language (called "FLE" for "Français Langue Étrangère")

Description of the program

French classes are running every work day between 10:00 am and 03:30 pm.

Full attendance includes 2 hours of Group classes. Each participant can also book 30 minutes of optional Tutoring per week.

In May/June, your French level will be assessed by an external teacher. In July, participants receive their Certificate of level in French language.

Group classes

Group classes are held twice a week for one hour. In September there are 6 groups of level starting with Group 6, for the complete beginners, up to Group 1, for the learners approaching the level B1. New groups will open in 2022 with the newcomers that will be complete beginners.





Individual tutoring Sessions

The Tutoring sessions are optional, but highly recommended, and have to be booked in advance via a monthly calendar. These sessions were designed to help learners **improve their speaking skills**. The teacher can also help each learner with their specific needs, finding new learning strategies, taking into account mother tongue, preferences and learning style.

Each participant can book 1 Tutoring session a week with maximum 2 participants of the same level by session.

French Language Book

In class, we use the book "EDITO Méthode de Français" from Didier FLE. This book will grant you access to the e-book as well as audio and video resources related to your book. These online resources can be very handy in case you do not have the book in hand. To activate the online book, go to this website : http://www.editions-didier.fr/ and create your account. You'll need to enter your email address and the password which is the activation code given on the back of the cover page of your book.

Communication

Every last week of each month, the Welcome Office sends an email, to all learners, with the information for the following month including:

- the weekly classes schedule ;
- the link to book the individual Tutoring sessions;
- the link to inform the Welcome Office and the teachers of any foreseen absence.

Registration

To register, learners needs to:

- **fill-in** the AIF Registration Form
- and send back the Training Commitment Form to AIF signed by the learner and his IO manager to Magali.chabrand@iter.org

From September, all learners are placed in new groups and receive the Outlook invitations that include the Skype Meetings link for the group classes.

Description of the programs in Aix-en-Provence

These programs are open to all foreign adults holding a high school qualification and are not exclusively reserved for ITER learners.

Program 3 – Evening French classes

These distance learning courses run over 10 weeks with 2 hours per week on Wednesdays from 6pm to 8pm. (see the information in the SUFLE website).

2 groups are proposed, one for the beginner level A1, and one for the intermediate level (A2 and B1) if the University gets 9 participants enrolled/level. Each learner has to take an online test before being placed in a group/level.

→ Please note that the SUFLE is in the process of modifying the evening classes, this program will probably be updated later this year.

Program 5 – Full-Time Training

<u>SUFLE's full-time French courses</u> are open to all non-French-speaking foreign adults, from complete beginners to experienced users. The program includes 18 hours per week including the workshops (ateliers) and Phonetic classes.

The academic year is divided into 2 independent semesters: the participant can register either for the 1st semester (September-December), or for the 2nd semester (January-April) or for the full academic year (September-April).

This full-time training is a diploma course: it gives access to the <u>University</u> <u>Diploma of French Language and Culture</u>. This diploma corresponds to 30 ECTS credits (European credits) per semester for 18 hours of classes per week. Attendance is compulsory.

Students are evaluated throughout the semester by continuous assessment marks, and then at the end of the semester by a final exam for the language course. These exams are absolutely mandatory to obtain the grades of the French Language course and attendance at classes is compulsory. This training allows you to obtain an <u>Aix-Marseille University Diploma of "French Language and culture"</u> and 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).





Participants will receive a Student card and will get the benefits of university students: access to university's restaurants, libraries, sports centers and cultural activities as well as reductions in national museums, movie theaters...

Important note: The Program 5 is very intensive. Therefore, one semester in Program 5 will count as one full year in the two years of French language training provided by the Welcome Office AIF. Participants are entitled to register maximum twice to this program within the 2 years of training.

Please note that students are placed in the groups based on the online test that the SUFLE sends to new students. **The week before the semester starts**, the school publishes the list of groups and their weekly time table.



4/ CONTINUE FRENCH LANGUAGE STUDIES

For learners who have already reached the B1 level or the end of the two-year timescale with the Welcome Office of the AIF, they can continue their studies by enrolling individually in the school of their choice.
